## May: International discussion on gender equality

On May 21-25 the ÅIPI is happy to gather on Åland representatives from partner organizations in all countries where the ÅIPI has been co-operating on gender equality and empowerment since the foundation in 1992. In connection with the meeting, on the 23rd of May at 6 p.m. an open discussion held in Russian and Swedish, on the theme of gender equality, progress and challenges, will be arranged at the city library of Mariehamn.

## June: Anniversary garden party

On the Åland self-government day, 9th of June, a garden party to celebrate the 20th birthday of the Åland Islands Peace Institute will be held at Hamngatan 4 in Mariehamn on Åland. The programme starts with a ceremony where the real estate of Hamngatan 4 will be donated from the government, represented by member of the Åland government Gun-Mari Lindholm.

In connection with the youth camp Voices for Peace (see above) a concert with musicians from Armenia, Azerbaijan and Åland will be arranged in co-operation with the festival Islands of Peace.

## September: Language conference

On 27 September 2012 the Åland Islands Peace Institute, which has been responsible for the legal frameworks analyses within the ELDIA project ([www.eldia-project.org](http://www.eldia-project.org)), will arrange an open conference entitled "Changing Linguistic Landscapes". Keynote speakers will be Fernand de Varennes (University of Peking), Reetta Toivanen (University of Helsinki) and Sia Spiliopoulou Åkermark (The Åland Islands Peace Institute). The conference will include three panels which will deal with languages, law and multilingualism in broad conceptual and geographical contexts.
