Summer internship at the AIPI

Statements of interest for a summer internship at the Åland Islands Peace Institute can be submitted by email no later than 31 February. Applications should include a letter of motivation, highlighting also the applicant's qualifications and areas of interest, a full CV and the contact details to possible reference persons. Priority will be given to students with a manifest interest in one or more of the Institute's areas of interest. Applications shall be sent by email to Bror Myllykoski at bror(at)peace.ax. Decisions are made within the month of March.

The Åland Islands Peace Institute works practically and with research into peace and conflict issues in a broadly defined sense, with Åland and the special status that Åland enjoys under international law as a point of departure. The Peace Institute is an independent charitable foundation founded in 1992. The Board of the Institute takes decisions on the overall activities of the Institute, while the Research Council is responsible for the scientific direction of the research activities of the Institute. The Åland Islands Peace Institute offers its interns a stimulating professional environment, responsible tasks, supervision and feedback. We consider internships as a way to support education and the development of competence and expertise in our areas of interest. However, the Peace Institute has only limited capacities to host interns in terms of space and funding, which is why we cannot host all applicants.



As an intern you are not required to have a certain education background or study a specific subject as long as your areas of interest correspond to the Institute's, i.e. questions related to peace, security, minorities, autonomy and gender issues. We also host interns with an interest in IT, communication, our library and archive. Which task will be assigned to you depends on your own interests but also on our current projects and activities planned during the period of the internship.

For Ålandic students there is an opportunity to receive funding for an internship through AMS. Other interns are encouraged to apply for funding from their higher education institutions, foundations or other sources.

We can host interns throughout the whole year depending on the availability of workspace and supervision. During the summer months we can host a maximum of two to three interns.
